The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 28829/24), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The National Medical Card Unit reviewed the assessable income applicable to persons aged Over 70. From 17th August 2022 the Living Alone Allowance (LAA) is no longer assessed as reckonable income for Medical Cards.
