The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position;

<b>CAMHS</b>	511 Therapeutic Sessions
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The multidisciplinary team provides care to the POLL service users within the catchment area who require more intensive input through one to one and group therapy sessions. Medical and nursing clinics are also carried out for initial assessment of new patients and review of existing service users. Allied Health professionals also provide one to one sessions with service users of the POLL 3 services.

There is currently no record of attendances being recorded for the POLL services at the E-Mental Health Hub, Castlerea
