To ask the Minister for Health whether payment has been issued to GPs for the treatment of patients aged 30-35 under the contraception scheme; and if not, when it is expected to issue payment. -Holly Cairns

Dear Deputy Cairns,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 32771/24), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Pursuant to the provisions of Clause 13 of the Free Contraception Service Contract with Registered Medical Practitioners, the current scheme has been further extended to include 'Relevant Women' aged 31-35 (inclusive) with effect from 1st July 2024 and payment will be due for claims received after this date in GP's August 2024 reimbursement.

I hope this clarifies the matter.
