The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above parliamentary question which you submitted to the Minister for response.

Since July 2023, NAS has introduced an additional 300 (approx.) defibrillators. The number of defibrillator failures in 2024 relate to the introduction of a new defibrillator model. NAS continue to engage with the supplier to ensure that no further failures occur.
