Dear Deputy MacLochlainn

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position for Community Healthcare Cavan Donegal Leitrim Monaghan Sligo.

The HSE can confirm, as previously advised, that there are no plans to move the services of the Public Health Nurse (PHN) from Fahan Health Centre and PHN services continue to be provided at the centre.

Fahan Health Centre will remain open for any patients in the Fahan area that have a nursing need and require a service from the PHN. It will continue to have a Nurse providing a service to all in Fahan and the surrounding areas.
