Dear Deputy Crowe,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 27546/24) which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Omnipod insulin pumps are currently not being supplied in Ireland. There may be some exceptional hardship cases where patients (current users) have moved to Ireland from other jurisdictions.

Omnipod 5 is being rolled out world-wide on a phased basis due to constraints in manufacturing capacity versus demand and they do not yet have a timeline for launch in Ireland.
