To ask the Minister for Health if further financial support can be granted to a community addiction group Willow Community Counselling Woodstock Street, Athy Co Kildare; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Sherlock,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you regarding your parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for a response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Health Service Executive confirms that HSE Addiction Services supports the provision of an integrated range of preventative, therapeutic, and rehabilitation services to meet the diverse health and social care needs of our service users in an accountable, accessible, and equitable manner. Willow Counselling receives annual funding of €40,000 from HSE Addictions Services. Willow Counselling has confirmed to the HSE that approximately 50% of their work relates to addiction as they also provide generic counselling.

Willow Counselling has been advised to investigate alternative sources of funding along with the existing funding form HSE Addiction Services. There was an additional once of funding of €7,500 euros provided in 2022 and 2023. This was provided to support the project.
