"To ask the Minister for Health if there is a dietitian service in County Kerry (details supplied); and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Details supplied: "Minister I have constituents who are waiting up to 6 years to be seen by a dietician in Co Kerry. Is this service not available as 6 years is an extraordinary length of time to be waiting."

Dear Deputy Healy-Rae,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed Primary Care Waiting list for Dietetics in Kerry and there is no client waiting 6 years to be seen. I can confirm 59% of patients are waiting under 52 weeks. As of 1st May 2024 there are 1860 patients on Primary Care Waiting list.

Currently only 33% of dietitian posts in Kerry are filled, the HSE recruitment pause continues to negatively impact on same and along with a national shortage of dietitians.

Please note that Dietetic prioritisation criteria ensures that we are seeing urgent cases in a timely manner.
