The MRI Scanner in Cavan General Hospital has recently has intermittent repair requirements. Any patients affected by this were promptly rescheduled.

Cavan General Hospital made an application to the HSE National Equipment Replacement Programme to replace the existing MRI Scanner located in the Radiology Department of Cavan General Hospital.

The project has been approved and works are expected to be completed by end of year, 2025.
