To ask the Minister for Health the reason there are no publicly funded routes to access diagnostic services in the southeast for autistic and ADHD adults, especially as public diagnostic services are seen elsewhere in the country, and private diagnosis can cost thousands of euros; and if she will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy McGuinness,

I have reviewed the matter and liaised with colleagues in disability services and the following is the current position.

Mental Health Services ADHD services for Adults

In 2025 Mental Health Services have received national funding approval to develop an Adult ADHD Team to serve IHA Waterford Wexford and IHA Carlow Kilkenny and South Tipperary areas. This funding will allow for the recruitment of a Consultant with administrative support, a Psychologist, an Occupational Therapist and a Clinical Nurse Specialist. Recruitment of these posts is being prioritised with a view (subject to successful recruitment) to having in place in Quarter 3 2025.

Disability Services - Autism

The pathway for access to services and assessment of autism for children is through the National Access Policy by referral to either Children's Disability Network Teams (CDNTs) or referral to Primary Care Therapy Assessment Team (PCAT). The focus for Adult Disability Services is to provide support for adults who have transitioned from Children's Disability Services or provision of services for adults that have received a diagnosis of a disability.
