"To ask the Minister for Health the amount spent by the HSE on agency staffing in each of the years from 2019 to 2024 and to date in 2025, in the acute mental health unit at Cork University Hospital; and the staff categories these relate to, in tabular form."

Dear Deputy Rice,

The Health Service Executive have been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted for the Minister for Health for a response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The HSE hires agency staff to ensure patient safety and maintain service delivery, particularly during staffing shortages, unplanned absences, or in areas with recruitment challenges. Agency workers provide essential flexibility and specialist skills, helping to uphold care standards and legal staffing requirements. While this approach supports continuity of care, it also presents financial challenges, prompting ongoing efforts to reduce reliance on agency staffing.
