PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health the number of new development jobs in CAMHS that are planned for each CHO area, in tabular form; and if she will make a statement on the matter. - Sorca Clarke

Dear Deputy Clarke,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The HSE's National Service Plan for 2024 outlined an investment of €162.8 million in new service developments, including enhancements to mental health and disability services. While specific allocations for CAMHS within this broader investment were not detailed in the available information, the €2.9 million funding for CAMHS initiatives in 2025 was part of these new service development.
