The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Representation which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Please see below:

Primary Care Child Psychology Services	Mayo (Network 1-3)	Network 9 (North Roscommon/ East Galway)
Total waiting list as of 01/03/2024	963	294
Waiting less than one year	412	161
Waiting 1-2 years	322	103
Waiting 2-3 years	207	30
Waiting 3-4 years	22	N/A
Longest waiting time	3 years 2 months	2 years 11 months

It is not possible to list all the waiting times of an excess of 1000 children, however as of March 1st, they range from 1 month to 3 years 2 months in Mayo and 1 month to 2 years 11 months in North Roscommon/East Galway (Network 9)
