Dear Deputy Cairns,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in regard to your parliamentary question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

I can advise that the Primary Care Child & Family Psychology Service is delivered by county and not Integrated Health Area across the HSE Mid West area (Limerick, Clare and Nth. Tipperary). The Principal Psychology Manager has provided the following breakdown regarding the number of children and adolescents (under 17 years) who are waiting an initial assessment/intervention by the Primary Care Psychology Service at the 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025:
