Dear Deputy Brabazon,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Raheny Health Centre is based in the Integrated Health Area Dublin North County area and provides Public Health Nursing services to the surrounding area.

Minor works funding was available for internal and external refurbishment in 2023. Internally, works included the installation of a new public bathroom, new flooring and LED energy efficient lighting throughout the building. New storage space for clinical waste bins, a new shed for additional storage and installation of a ramp at the front door were added externally to the building. There are no plans to further refurbish Raheny Health Centre at the present time.
