**PQ 17192/25 :** To ask the Minister for Health the number of nurses employed in each hospital in the State.

Dear Deputy Tóibín,

I refer to your recent parliamentary question in relation to staffing which was forwarded to the Health Services Executive (HSE) by the Department of Health for direct reply.

Health Services Personnel Census (HSPC) reports on direct employment in the provision of Health & Social Care Services by the HSE and the various Section 38 hospitals & agencies. Staff are reported on the basis of staff category and for the purposes of this PQ the relevant staff category is Nursing & Midwifery. HSPC details at the end of February 2025, show that were 148,799 WTE (equating to 167,479 personnel) directly employed in the provision of our services and of which 48,363 WTE (equating to 54,233 personnel) were Nurses & Midwives. A total of 31,277 WTE (equating to 34,851 personnel) are reported across our acute hospitals.

Details of Nursing & Midwifery WTE and headcount by acute hospital at February 2025 as requested by the Deputy are set out in the attached table.

Workforce reports are available through the Health Services Personnel Census (HSPC), which is the official employment count for the public health service. The latest published information is routinely published <u>here</u>.

I trust that this information is sufficient to meet the Deputy's needs.
