Dear Deputy Cullinane

I refer to your parliamentary question below which has been forwarded to me for attention.

PQ 17598/25 – To ask the Minister for Health her plans to widen or conduct a further clinical examination of pelvic osteotomies conducted on children with development dysplasia of the hip at Children's Health Ireland and National Orthopaedic Hospital Cappagh beyond the years 2021-2023; if so, the years concerned, the number of children concerned, and the number of surgeries by year of surgery, in tabular form.

Children's Health Ireland (CHI) Response:

Children's Health Ireland (CHI) and the National Orthopaedic Hospital Cappagh (NOHC) confirmed in July 2024 that it would undertake a joint clinical audit to look at a random and anonymised sample of DDH surgeries performed during the 2021-2023 period, after a concern was reported that the threshold criteria being used for surgical intervention in relation to DDH may have been different across CHI sites and NOHC. The audit is being conducted by a UK Paediatric Orthopaedic Consultant with specialist expertise in this area.

The audit is not yet complete, and so we cannot provide any details of its findings, and we cannot comment on any media reports in relation to the audit, as to do so would undermine the integrity of the audit process.

We will ensure our patients, and their families are kept informed as we move through this process, and will share findings of the audit once completed. In the meantime, we will be corresponding with families as appropriate.

CHI and NOHC are committed to improving access to quality care across our services and regularly undertakes quality assurance checks in line with HSE standards.
