To ask the Minister for Health the number of public defibrillators in each local authority area; and how those numbers compare to 2020, in tabular form. -Ivana Bacik

Dear Deputy,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the National Ambulance Service for response.

- By end of year 2020, NAS was notified of the location of 2161 publicly available AEDs.
- To date, the NAS has been notified of a total of 4,312 publicly available automated external defibrillators (AEDs).
- This represents an increase of 2,151 AEDs held on the NAS database since EOY 2020.

Please see Table 1 overleaf for a breakdown of this total by county.

It is important to note that public defibrillators are not provided by the NAS, but when an AED is publically accessible, it can be added to the NAS database, and the location can be made visible to our NAS Emergency Call Takers. In the event of a 112/999 call being made to NAS for a person who may require an AED, if there is an AED available in the vicinity of the incident, the emergency call taker will be able to direct the caller to the AED location so that it can be brought to the patient.

This process is managed by the NAS Community Engagement Team in collaboration with the NAS Informatics Team. While we can provide information on the number of publicly accessible defibrillator locations that NAS has been notified about by county, we would expect that there are considerably more publicly accessible defibrillators in the country than NAS have not been notified about.
