Dear Deputy Quaide,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The former health centre at Ballynoe, Co. Cork is surplus to requirement and will be disposed of in line with the HSE Property Protocol and the Department of Public Expenditure, NDP Delivery and Reform Circular 11/15 (Protocols for the Transfer and Sharing of the State Property Assets) whereby it will be offered to State Stakeholders before being placed on the open market for disposal.

The property will require First Registration of title before a sale can be effected.
