HSE Dublin and North East has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Having reviewed the matter, the following outlines the position.

The MRI Scanner in Cavan General Hospital has recently had intermittent repair requirements. Any patients affected by this were promptly rescheduled.

Cavan General Hospital made an application to the HSE National Equipment Replacement Programme to replace the existing MRI Scanner located in the Radiology Department of Cavan General Hospital.

The project has been approved and works are expected to be completed by end of year, 2025.
