To ask the Minister for Children; Equality; Disability; Integration and Youth the waiting-list numbers and exact wait-times in months and years, per discipline, for young people in each Integrated health area of the Dublin and south east regional health area children's disability network teams, in tabular form; to include numbers of years waiting for young people waiting more than twelve months; and the longest wait-time in years and months as of 1`April 2025.

Dear Deputy Quaide,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter, and the following is the current position.

HSE Children's Disability Services has undergone significant reforms and restructuring over the past three years with the implementation of the Progressing Disability Services (PDS). The core focus of this change is to ensure that children and their families, with complex interdisciplinary needs, will receive an appropriate and accessible family centred service.

All children on CDNT registers, both CDNT waiting lists and open caseloads are likely to be waiting for some aspect of their intervention. As an interdisciplinary service, vacancies for some disciplines can further restrict the capacity to provide an intervention that requires more than one discipline.

The tables in Appendix 1 (attached) provide data on waiting lists for CDNTs across the integrated healthcare areas (IHAs) in HSE Dublin and South East. These numbers are based on the most recent data available which is captured at a specific point in time and subject to change. It should be noted that there are some variations in data collation across IHA areas. With the development of the new Dublin and East Region there will be an ongoing focus on data integration across our systems.

As with other areas, Disability Services are continuing to experience recruitment challenges. The HSE is operating in a very competitive market as there are significant shortages of qualified healthcare professionals nationally and internationally. HSE Dublin and South East continues to prioritise posts for all disciplines and to express posts out to current national panels where relevant.

The HSE acknowledge that waiting times for CDNT services at this time are not appropriate and particularly stressful for children and their families and will continue to



explore a range of options to enhance the recruitment and retention of essential staff into our CDNTs.
