\*2374. To ask the Minister for Health to provide a breakdown for posts to be delivered in the National Ambulance Service; the date by which she expects recruitment to be commenced; and if she will make a statement on the matter. — John Brady. [20522/25]

Dear Deputy Brady,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Formal approval for 180 new service development posts in 2025 is expected to take effect from July 2025. The Part Year funding for 2025 ( $\in$ 8m) is expected to increase to full year funding effect in 2026 ( $\in$ 16m).

At this stage, I can confirm the following NAS services or transformation programmes are prioritised within the proposed developments, some of which still remain subject to formal approval, approval of a number of new grade codes, resolution of an industrial relations dispute before the WRC and the HSE' employment control arrangements:
