Dear Deputy Hearne,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you with information in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted for response. I examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Integrated Health Area Dublin North County (IHA DNC) and Integrated Health Area Dublin North City & West (IHA DNCW), formerly known as CHO comprises 12 Children's Disability Network Teams (CDNTs). The CDNTs are managed by three lead agencies which include St Michael's House (SMH), Avista and the Central Remedial Clinic (CRC) and the HSE manage 2 of the CDNTs.

The below table outlines each team and Service Provider with a summary of the numbers of children waiting for some CDNT services. The information in table is accurate as of the last day of January 2025.

Please be assured Disability Services are working to improve the waiting times experienced by some children. The CDNTs support families of children whilst they are awaiting services through various intervention initiatives, including access to webinars, workshops, advice clinics, group interventions among other options.
