** STREAM is a Mental Health Service that aims to provide support and treatment for the recovery of service users with Eating Disorders in Cork Kerry Community Healthcare. STREAM was established in line with the HSE Model of Care for Eating Disorders. The service is an adult service so anyone over the age of 18 can attend/ be referred. There is no fee attached to the service so no medical card or health insurance is required.

- ✓ 1.0 WTE Clinical Specialist Dietitian for STREAM services
- ✓ 1.0 WTE Clinical Specialist Dietitian for CAREDS service.

The relevant paperwork is being completed and we hope to start the recruitment process in the coming weeks.
