The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you with information in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted for response. I examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The table below provides the number of Whole-Time Equivalent (WTE) clinical psychologists based at St Michael’s House (SMH) Kilbarrack Children’s Disability Network Team (CDNT) as of 28th January 2025 and as of 28th January 2022.

Psychologists on Kilbarrack CDNT January 2025	2.2 WTE
Psychologists on Kilbarrack CDNT January 2022	3 WTE

Regarding the above figures, Kilbarrack CDNT has an allocation of 4.2 WTE Psychology posts. Two of these posts are currently on Maternity Leave.
