PQ 6128/25* To ask the Minister for Health the capital works projects that were carried out at Saint Joseph's Hospital, Dublin 5 in the years of 2023 and 2024; the future capital works projects that are scheduled to be carried out at this hospital over the next 18 months; and if she will make a statement on the matter. -Tom Brabazon

Dear Deputy Brabazon,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I can confirm capital works were invested in the Saint Joseph's Hospital Campus in 2023 and 2024 for:

1. Minor capital investment carried out in relation to fire safety works. The exact expenditure cannot be provided as this was part of a larger project across both the St. Joseph's Hospital and Beaumont Hospital Campus.
2. Approximately €215,000 Energy capital investment on the campus including window upgrade works underway as well as other ancillary works.

The 2025 HSE Capital Plan includes for the provision for replacement of an existing CT scanner and associated infrastructure works under the HSE's Equipment Replacement Programme. The Capital Plan also includes for a diagnostics project on the campus to incorporate a stand-alone diagnostic centre on the St Joseph's site under the governance of Beaumont Radiology Department. This project is currently at Stage 1 Design.
