The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The table below outlines the funded posts for South Lee and the vacancies as at February 2025. With regards to the WLI posts please note that these are not South Lee designated posts but are staffing for CKCH wide initiatives. The South Lee waitlist does benefit when staff are in place as these initiatives intervene with longest waiting / those waiting over 52 weeks and for the PDS transferred group added to waitlist in 2021.
