Dear Deputy O'Rourke,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outlined the position as follows.

There has been no change to transport and Prosper Meath Services in the last three years. Historically, some transport was provided by Meath Disability Services, however there is no capacity on these routes at present.

Day Services do not have a separate budget for transport. That said, the HSE works collaboratively with providers to identify solutions in supporting service users access their Day Services.
