The number of persons in Roscommon waiting for an appointment with a CAMHS team; the number waiting 0 to 12, 12 to 26,26 to 52 and more than 52 weeks, respectively

Dear Deputy Daly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position;

There are 11 young people awaiting an initial assessment for Roscommon/East Galway CAMHS as per the latest published waiting list performance data as at the end of Jan 2025. Of these, 9 are new referrals, awaiting an initial assessment within the timeframe of the CAMHS Operating Guidelines, i.e. first appointment within 12 weeks of referral. The remaining 2 have been waiting between 12 -26 weeks.
