The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 8068/25) which you submitted for a response. Sincere apologies in the delay in coming back to you. I have linked with our local HSE Estates Department, and the following outlines the current position.

The Stakeholders involved in discussions regarding the draft report include the various Service Divisions within the HSE i.e. Mental Health, Older Persons, Disability, Maintenance, National Ambulance Service etc. In addition various external agencies such as Galway County Council, Department of Education, Uisce Éireann have all been contacted in relation to the disposal of assets deemed surplus to HSE requirements.

As previously notified by the HSE, it is the intention of the HSE to dispose of assets deemed surplus to the requirements of the HSE. In this context assets will be disposed of in line with the HSE Property Protocol and State Circulars
