Integrated Health Areas of Dublin North County and Dublin North City & West Primary Care Unit team have advised the information required is not readily available within the Primary Care Unit. However, we can provide the information as at the end of 2024 the number of registered GMS GPs within the Integrated Health Areas of Dublin North County and Dublin North City & West areas requested as follows:
