“To ask the Minister for Health if a pause remains in place on approving all capital proposals associated with each hospital that has yet to demonstrate compliance with the health performance visibility platform programme.”

Dear Deputy Sherlock,

The process for approving digital projects and programmes has been developed to ensure that all proposals align with our Digital for Care strategy, align with the governance and approval process while being agile to reflect the service requirements. The approval process is aligned to Dept of Public Expenditure Circular 14/21, which the HSE seeks approval from the Dept. of Health and DPENAIR, this is undertaken monthly.

The HSE has the option to reject an ICT Capital proposal if it does not comply with the Health Performance Visualisation Platform (HPVP) implementation. However, so far, the HSE has not had to reject any ICT Capital proposal due to non-compliance with the HPVP project. All hospitals within the scope of the programme are working closely with the HSE on their HPVP project delivery.
