"To ask the Minister for Health the reason not every hospital has yet to go live with the health performance visibility platform system; and if she believes she will get 100% compliance and the actions she has taken to ensure every hospital does implement it."

Dear Deputy Sherlock,

Data is being loaded from all 28 hospitals intended for Phase 1 roll out of the Health Performance Visualisation Platform system. This data load process relies on complex technical integration from a range of different data sources across these hospitals and then subsequent reviewing of this data from a quality perspective. There are 2 hospitals in the final stages of this the technical implementation process and are expected to go live in the coming weeks.

Having access to this data has allowed the HSE to visualise this information in a standardised and consistent format not just across the organisation but also allowing the HSE to publish this

activity and performance data to the wider public via HSE Live monthly. These can be found at <a href="https://www2.hse.ie/services/activity-performance-data/">https://www2.hse.ie/services/activity-performance-data/</a>.

There is also a renewed focus on the use of data and analytics in the HSE with the recent appointment of a Chief Data and Analytics Officer (CDAO). This is an important step in strengthening our data and analytics capabilities, ensuring we continue to provide safe, effective, and efficient care across the health service.
