## Dear Deputy Wall,

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Children; Equality; Disability; Integration and Youth to the Health Service Executive for direct response. I requested that a Business Manager examine the matter and the following outlines the position.

With regard to Sensational Kids proposed Building Project, the HSE confirmed that a clear funding plan setting out the HSE capital requirement was required in order that the HSE could consider it for discussion and inclusion on the 2024 Capital Plan proposals. As the clarification was not available at that time, it was not possible to include in the 2024 Capital Plan.

HSE Estates provided Sensational kids with the Capital Projects Manual & Approvals Protocol and advised the organisation of the requirement for public tendering on a publicly funded capital project. HSE confirmed that Capital funding must go through the capital estates procurement processes and that HSE will only be able to provide capital funding for projects that have proceeded through the necessary due diligence considerations, in the context of an agreed service arrangement.

We confirm that HSE have not as yet received a Capital application for the New National Child Development Centre, Kildare Town. Sensational Kids met with HSE Estates on 5th February. The meeting included confirming the Capital Application process and SHIF (Strategic Healthcare Investment Framework) Alignment Form was provided.
