Dear Deputy Connolly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

It is the intention of the HSE to deliver a new Primary Care Centre in Oranmore, Co. Galway that end a tender process was initiated via advertisement on the E-Tenders Procurement Platform. There are two stages to this current procurement process. The publication on the E-tenders Procurement Platform is the first stage in the procurement process. The second stage is the Invitation to Tender where priced offer proposals are sought, to be followed by an evaluation of same. Tenders were returned at the end of March 2025.

The evaluation process for Oranmore Primary Care Centre is progressing and the approval process of the preferred tender is underway.
