<u>Re:</u> PQ 37946/25 "To ask the Minister for Health the number of units of treatment delivered utilising a linear accelerator which were delivered through outsourcing in 2024, for each provider, in tabular form; and the details of total payments made to each provider for that period for such services."

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

In response to PQ37946/25 "To ask the Minister for Health the number of units of treatment delivered utilising a linear accelerator which were delivered through outsourcing in 2024, for each provider, in tabular form; and the details of total payments made to each provider for that period for such services."

Table 1 shows the cost, number of patients and number of fractions of radiotherapy outsourced by SLRON in 2024.

A radiotherapy fraction refers to a dose of radiation delivered to a patient in the course of one visit to a Radiotherapy Department.
