Dear Deputy Ó Snodaigh

I refer to your parliamentary question below which has been forwarded to me for attention.

PQ 40296/25 – To ask the Minister for Health if there will be sufficient car parking spaces in the new Children's Hospital and the associated Ronald McDonald House to cater for the demand of spaces from the parents of in-patients, those at the paediatric accident and emergency department and those children who must attend as out-patients; and if she will make a statement on the matter.

Children's Health Ireland (CHI) Response:

Children's Health Ireland (CHI) can advise that there are 991 car parking spaces at the National Children's Hospital Ireland (NCHI) with 675 car parking spaces allocated for the use of patients, parents & carers at the NCHI, including 31 spaces adjacent to the Accident and Emergency Department and 316 spaces allocated for staff.
