**PQ ref 41734/25** - To ask the Minister for Children; Disability and Equality the average waiting time for an occupational therapist to make an assessment for a housing adaptation in the CHO7 area.

Dear Deputy Crowe

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in regard to your parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for a response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Health Service Executive can confirm that the waiting time for housing adaptation grant depends on the functional need/risk identified on referrals which guides prioritisation given for Occupational Therapy service provision.
