The Health Service Executive has been requested to respond to your parliamentary question submitted to the Minister for Children, Disability and Equality.

HSE South West Disability Services, key performance indicator (KPI) data for Q1 2025 (January – March) for Home Support and Personal Assistants is outlined in Tables 1 and 2 below. Data for Q2 2025 is likely to be available from mid-August, 2025.
