To ask the Minister for Health if a medication (details supplied) is prescribed by the complex menopause service at CUMH for women who are HRT contraindicated; the status on this medication being available on the drugs payments scheme; and if she will make a statement on the matter. -Aindrias Moynihan

Dear Deputy Moynihan,

The Health Service Executive has been asked to respond directly to your Parliamentary Question. The following outlines our response:

The CUMH Complex Menopause Clinic would prescribe Veoza for the treatment of moderate to severe vasomotor symptoms associated with menopause, as it is particularly beneficial for patients who cannot take HRT due to contraindications.

However, to date, the clinic has not had a patient who met the specific criteria for Veoza prescription. This is due to various factors, including the eligibility requirements. As far as we are aware, Veoza is not available on the drugs payments scheme.
