Dear Deputy Bacik,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

At present there are 7 Primary Care Centres currently in construction with further 35 centres in development with preferred providers identified. There are a further 36 Primary Care Centres at various stages of the tender process.

While all projects go through internal reviews at various stages of their lifecycle to ensure value for money, there are no primary care centre projects currently stalled, suspended or otherwise in abeyance due to the need to review leasing costs.
