PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health the average wait time for urgent referrals for counselling services, by regional health area and integrated healthcare area, in tabular form. – Padraig Rice

Dear Deputy Rice,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Referrals to the the HSE National Counselling Service are screened according to agreed eligibility criteria and if assessed as appropriate for counselling are placed on the waiting list in chronological order.

Counselling is not an urgent response service. The NCS does not maintain a waiting list for urgent referrals.

The table below indicates the latest available information for the number of people waiting for counselling and average waiting times at **30.6.2025**. Figures are provided by Health Region, LHO, and length of time waiting.
