Dear Deputy Cooney,

The data below has been extracted from DIME (Doctors Integrated Management E-system) as at 31st December 2023 - 2024 and May 2025. As DIME is a live system it must be noted that there can be variances in the figures published dependent on the run date of the report as entries can be made with a retrospective date.

This data is based on the number of Consultants employed in the Medical Discipline of Emergency Medicine at the time of date provided, by headcount and matched to a post (CAAC approved and unapproved) on DIME for sites; Mater University Hospital, Tallaght University Hospital, Beaumont Hospital, St. James's Hospital, St. Vincent's Hospital, University Hospital Galway, Cork University Hospital and University Hospital Waterford listed as the <u>Principal Clinical Site</u>.

As the data is based on principal clinical site only it should be further noted that there may be other Consultants who also have a clinical commitment to the eight clinical sites listed.
