PQ 29802/25 To ask the Minister for Children; Disability and Equality the number of people in receipt of blind welfare allowance for the years 2020 to 2025, by county; and if she will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy O'Shea,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 29802/25) which you submitted to the Minister for Children, Disability and Equality for response.

Blind Welfare Allowance is a means-tested payment from the Health Service Executive (HSE) for people aged 18 or over who are blind or visually impaired and meet the defined eligibility criteria.

The HSE initially collated the number of Blind Welfare Allowance (BWA) recipients at December 2022 and has also collated the number of BWA recipients at December 2023 and December 2024. The available data for BWA recipients is collated by CHO area currently data for each county is not available.

The table below outlines the numbers of recipients for yearend 2022, 2023 and 2024. 2025 data will be collected in early 2026.
