**PQ 29926/25 - To ask the Minister for Health the amount of money earned by public consultants working at weekends on waiting list initiatives including ones funded by the NTPF from 2010 to date, broken down by year, by hospital, by speciality and by amounts earned in each year in bands (details supplied); and if she will make a statement on the matter.**

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

**Response:**

Access to Care funding is targeted funding available to hospitals for waiting list initiatives and measures to increase capacity and assist with reform and innovation. This funding is released to the individual hospitals directly. This information in relation to the money earned by public Consultants is not available at a National level as hospitals have oversight of waiting lists initiatives.

Alternatively, I am providing attached the Access to Care spend on insourcing 2023-2025.

The Health Service Executive CEO has recently conducted a review and produced a report *Insourcing Outsourcing CEO Report June 2024* available at <https://www.gov.ie/en/department-of-health/publications/minister-for-health-publishes-insourcing-and-outsourcing-report-a-review-hse-june-2025/>

The National Treatment Purchase Fund (NTPF) also has funded insourcing with individual hospitals.
