HSE Dublin and North East has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Having reviewed the matter, the following outlines the position.

Total expenditure YTD on the proposal to relocate to Connolly Hospital campus is €804,059. This was primarily in the period 2016-2018. All expenditure to date on this proposal has been expensed and funded by the Rotunda Board from its own reserves as a Voluntary Hospital. This included a Design Brief/Activity Model/Report on services in Connolly/CBA/Project office pay and non- pay costs
