HSE Dublin and North East has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Having reviewed the matter, the following outlines the position.

I can confirm that MRI pelvis scans are routinely performed under the 'GP Access to Community Diagnostics' scheme for medical card holders in our Lady's Hospital, Navan. MRI pelvis (gynaecological) scans are not performed, as they are not covered under this scheme.
