Re PQ 31931 25: To ask the Minister for Health if pay increases for section 39 workers, under the recent agreement reached at the WRC to fund health, social care and homeless sector employers, will automatically take effect, or if the organisations concerned need to reapply for funding.

Dear Deputy Dempsey,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Your PQ above has been referred to me for response.

All Section 39 organisations that made an application for funding under the previous agreement will be eligible to receive additional funding commensurate with the terms of the most recent agreement reached at the WRC. The determination of this funding will be evaluated based on data previously received per the original application submitted by each organisation. Funding will then be distributed to all eligible organisations following a validation exercise to be undertaken under the auspices of the HSE.
