Dear Deputy Brennan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

As communicated, the need for a new Primary Care Centre in Gorey had been previously identified. A tender process had been undertaken, and a Preferred Provider had been selected. Unfortunately, the selected Preferred Provider encountered difficulties regarding the economic viability of the proposed project, resulting in the collapse of this process.

To facilitate the re-advertisement of this Primary Care Centre, a full review of the current and future service needs was undertaken with relevant stakeholders. There are a number of stakeholders and services who require accommodation in the new proposed Primary Care Centre and a scope has been established based on all updated service requirements. This review is now complete and approval obtained to progress with Stage 1 of the tender process.

The Stage 1 Tender advertisement was published on the E-Tenders Procurement Platform on 24th June 2025.
