Dear Deputy,

I refer to your recent Parliamentary Question which was sent to the HSE for response.

The Health Service Executive (HSE) is committed to facilitating blended working arrangements for public health service employees whose roles can be performed remotely.

[HR Circular 033/2022 - HSE Blended Working Policy for the Public Health Service](#) issued on the 22nd December 2022 is the overarching Blended Working Policy for the HSE and Section 38 organisations and requires managers to identify which roles are suitable for remote working and determine how the implementation of blended working arrangements will align with the business/service needs of the organisation/division/unit.

We do not have the information on the number of people engaging with this policy this is managed within the services and is not collated centrally.
